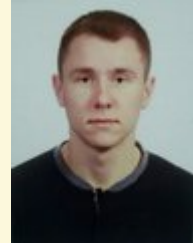

Autobiography

From May 2016 to August 2016 I picked strawberries in Finland.

Then I went to Norway and worked there on a dairy farm. My daily duties included taking care of cows and calves, feeding, mixing of food, milking with a robot, tractor work, cutting grass, spraying fields, driving a tractor with a trailer.

In summer 2019 I was on a seasonal job in Germany. I was picking cherries, also I worked as a driver.

I can speak English well due to staying in Australia. As for my hobbies I am a sporty person and am fond of football, volleyball and table tennis. I am physically strong and healthy, positive, and honest.
